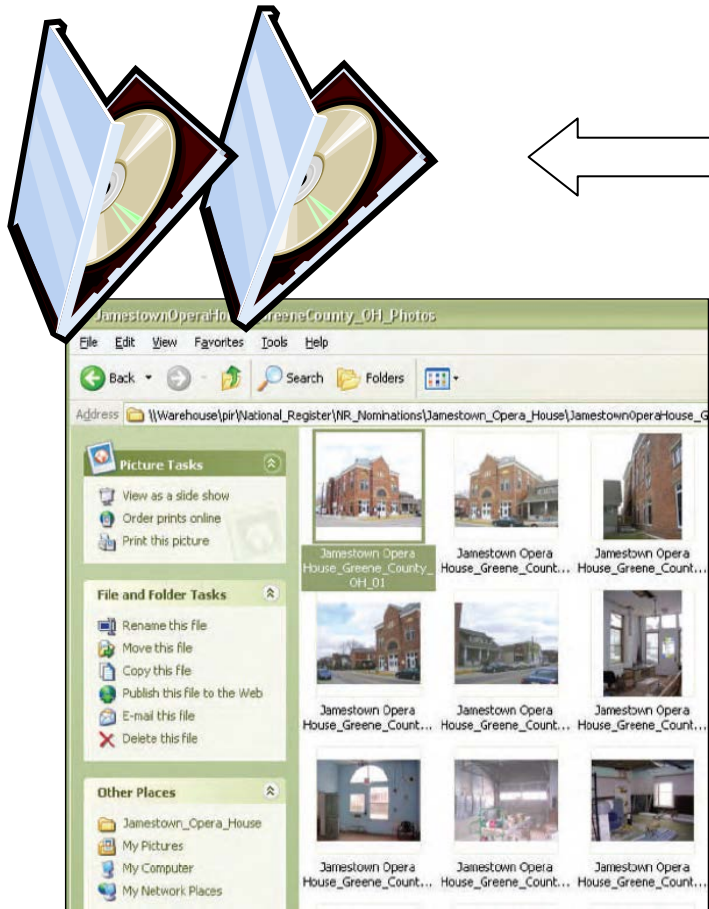


## Submitting Digital Photos? A Few Things that are Important to Know...

If you are submitting digital photos, the *final* nomination\* (see notation below) must include 2 CDs or DVDs with the photos saved as .tiff (Tagged Image File Format) files. The digital photos on the CD/DVDs must be in color and must be named with the NPS specified naming convention.

\*With your *first* draft submission, you can choose to send only the CD with color, .tiff images correctly labeled. We can review these images and then respond back to you either to go ahead and get prints made, or if the images need adjusted, to address any issues and then send prints in with the second submission of the photo CD.

**F**inal photo submissions must also include 2 sets of black and white prints, according to OHPO standards. If you chose to submit an all-digital nomination packet (see GIS Mapping Guidance) only one set of prints is required. Please also carefully review National Park Service photo guidelines. The prints must be printed with acceptable paper and ink combinations per NPS standards for digital photo submissions. (See enclosed photo checklist/NPS policy)
